- A cover letter that includes statements of research interests and reasons/motivations for pursuing an MS/PhD and type of career (i.e., a brief summary; especially your specific research interests and how you envision creating synergy within the research programs in my lab and larger MSU community - hydroecology, groundwater-surface water interactions, watershed hydrology, and/or aquatic biogeochemistry).
- 3. List of 3 References with their contact information
- 4. Example(s) of your scientific writing (e.g., peer-reviewed publications, proposals, in prep/review manuscripts)

You will also need to prepare to formally apply to one of the Earth and Environmental Sciences graduate programs before December 1. Information for those procedures can be found here:
